

Vishnusahasranama reprinting in Kannada

The Brihatisahasra stotra(incantation), containing one thousand sacred hymns from R^igveda in BrihatI meter, from its embedded 72 thousand letters, is reckoned as “jIvanashAstra”, extolling the 72 thousand Divine forms of Almighty, controlling 36 thousand days and 36 thousand nights of Full hundred-year life-span of every human being, which corresponds to the 72 thousand Divine forms of Almighty energizing the 72 thousand nADis present in the body of every human being. The thousand sacred hymns of Brihatisahasra constitute Vishnusahasranama. In other words, each sacred hymn of Brihatisahasra is in the form of the commentary of one name of the Lord in VishnusahasranAma. Hence, just like Brihatisahasra, Vishnusahasranama is also “jIvanashAstra”.
